**WHAT "bread" do you need today?**

forgive everyone who is indebted to us."* Luke 11:4a

**WHAT sins do you need to confess and be forgiven for today?  
And who do you need to forgive?**

\_\_\_\_\_ *"And do not lead us into temptation, but  
deliver us from the evil one."* Luke 11:4b

**WHAT temptation are you facing right now that you need to  
escape from?**
